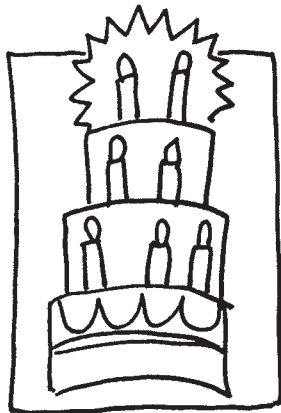


MAKE YOUR OWN BIRTHDAY CAKE

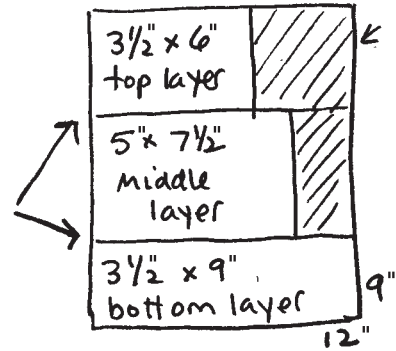
(with help from an adult)



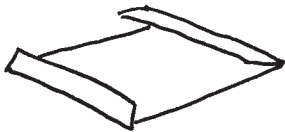
Make a 3-D birthday cake!

①

Precut a variety of 9" x 12" colored construction paper. Speed tip: Make these cuts first, then trim top two layers. Save all scraps for cake decorations. Cut enough for students to mix and match layers.

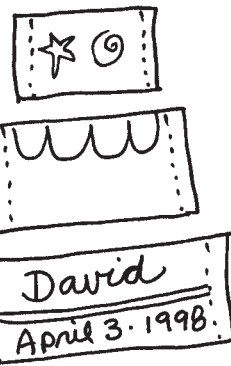
Fold under 1/2" on each short end. (This will be approximate.)

Flatten with thumbnail.

Bend fold back so layer lies flat for decorating.

Decorate!

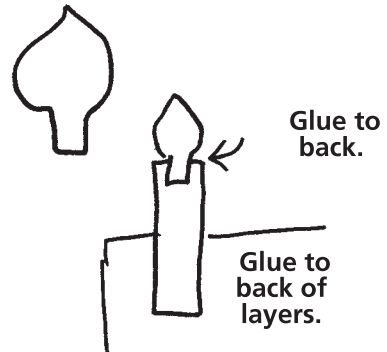


Cut shapes. ☆ ○ ♥

Add name? Birthdate?

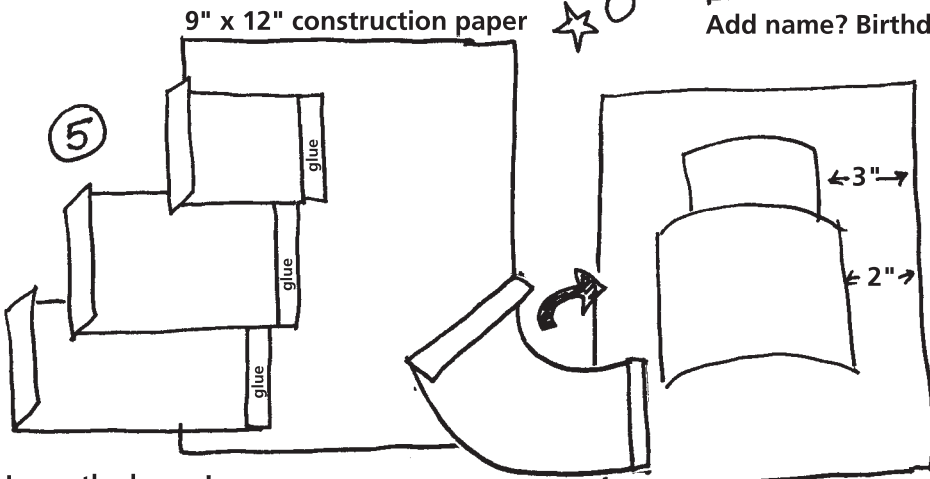
Candles – cut 1/2" x 3" strips in a variety of colors. Cut flames with tabs.



Glue to back.

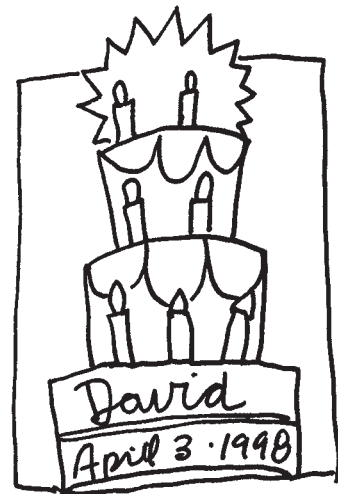
Glue to back of layers.

Layer the layers! Start at the bottom. Set 1 inch from edge. Work up with 1/4" overlap, glue in place. (Shown here without decoration.)

Start at top layer. Bend. Glue (if patient). Tape (if not!)



Want to add a sun at top? Try this simple technique.



Draw around a plate. Cut out.



Snip out pizza shapes. Turn circle to cut as you go!
